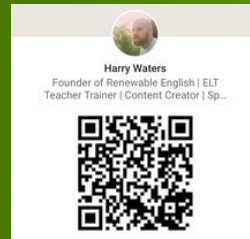

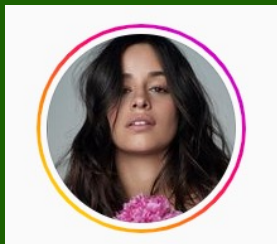

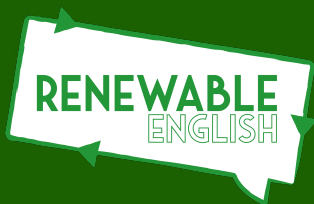

SIX TYPES OF CHANGEMAKERS

Type	Medium of Change	Examples	Ashoka Fellow Example
1. Social Architect	social structures (roles and flow of resources)	designers, policy makers, organizational leaders	Jimmy Wales, Wikipedia, created mechanism for democratizing knowledge creation
2. Influencer	thinking and decisions	educators, researchers, journalists, parents	Mary Gordon, Roots of Empathy, influenced Canadian early childhood education norms
3. Investors	resources (funding, in-kind)	impact investors, philanthropists	Nobel Laureate Muhammad Yunus, Grameen Bank, enabled millions in funding via microloans



4.Skills Catalyzers	expert resources (including skills)	accountants, lawyers, mediators, computer programmers	Ami Dar, Idealist.org, connected millions of job-seekers to social sector organization needs - demonstrating the needs for skilled professionals in changemaking
5.Inventor	technology, tools	engineers, scientists,	Lassane Savadogo, ASPMY, created food storage systems that double local income.
6. Connector	Relationships	conveners, community organizers	Nobel Laureate Kailash Satyarthi, Global March Against Child Labor, alliance among 2,000+ organizations

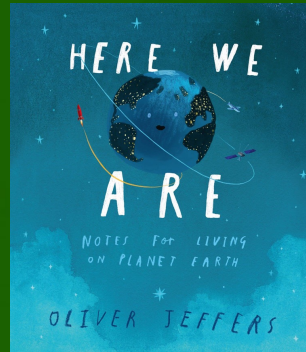
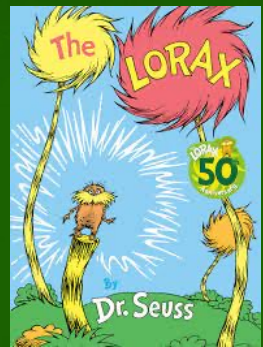

RECIPE (4 servings, 60min prep time):
-1/2 cup (125ml) orange juice
-6 Tbsp soy sauce
-1 Tsp chili paste
-a handful chopped cilantro
-2 Tsp each cumin and oregano
-2 limes, juiced
-1/4 cup (60ml) olive oil
-450g mushrooms (I used king oyster mushrooms)
Marinate at least 30mins.
"Salsa verde":
-a bunch cilantro or parsley
-2 cloves garlic
-4 Tbsp vegan yogurt
-4 Tbsp vegan mayo
-1/2 lemon
-1 Tsp cumin
-1 Tsp agave
-salt to taste
Blend until smooth.
Serve in soft taco shells.

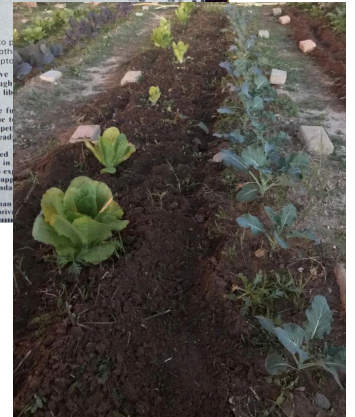

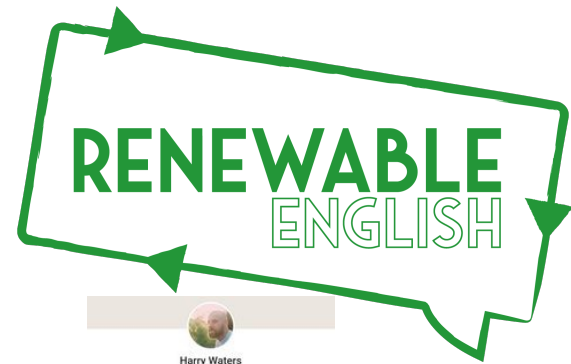

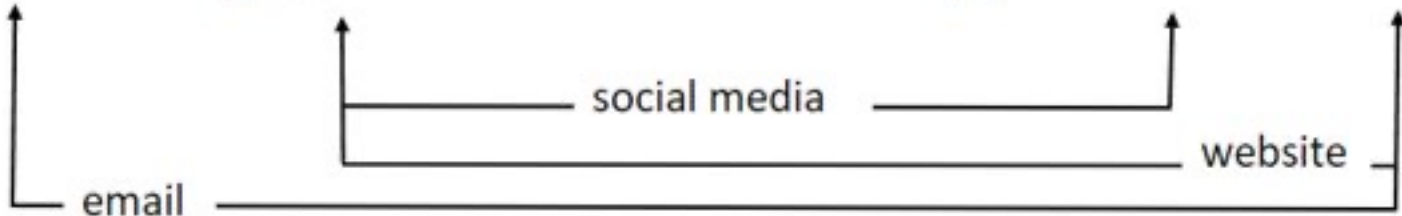
