## Course details

This 15-hour online course offers teacher support over 3 weeks/ 4 weekends that encourages teachers to prepare candidates for the Independent Listening Task of Trinity College London's Integrated Skills in English at Foundation and ISE I levels.

The main aims are:

- To familiarise participants with the format of the ISE Foundation and ISE I independent listening tasks
- To encourage participants to reflect on the skills students need to develop to do well on ISE Foundation and ISE I Independent Listening Tasks
- To provide teaching ideas and practical tips for preparing students for the ISE Foundation and ISE I Independent listening task
- To help participants to develop and share their own teaching ideas for the ISE Foundation and ISE I Independent Listening tasks

This course includes:

- Challenging and inspiring resources
- Tasks to encourage a reflective approach
- Activity-based learning where participants also create classroom resources
- Discussion forums for participants to share their views and learn from colleagues.
