

## Keeper of the keys

 10 minutes  Whole class

**An exercise that will develop students' teamwork and strategy skills as they work together, using all their senses, to solve a shared challenge.**

- Ask the group to stand in a circle around a stool or chair.
- Select a player to be 'keeper of the keys' and invite them to sit on the chair in the centre of the circle.
- Place a set of keys underneath the chair and blindfold the 'keeper of the keys'.
- Students in the circle must try to take the keys without the 'keeper' noticing.
- If the 'keeper' hears someone attempting to steal the keys, they must point to where they think the keys have been taken. If correct, the student who has been caught must return to the circle and start again.
- Once the keys have been successfully stolen, the 'keeper' (with blind fold removed) gets three guesses to see who has the keys.
