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This classic game introduces students to the important improvisation concept of agreeing to or building on the suggestions or stimulus given to them.

 \cdot To play this game, the group can either stand in a circle or move around the room if space allows.

-The teacher starts the activity by giving the first suggestion, for example 'Let's jump up and down!'. The actions need to be easily repeatable by the whole group.

• The group needs to answer 'Yes, let's!' and all start jumping up and down.

• They continue this action until someone else call's out 'Let's…!' and suggests another action.

• The group needs to respond with 'Yes, let's!' and copies the action.

• Encourage all students to suggest an action.
